
How exciting!

You will bring in your water bottle and put it on the trolley in the classroom. If you bring in a packed lunch from home, you can put this on the trolley as well.




Wow, look at your new classroom! There are lots of things to do

This is Mr Hyatt. He is the Executive Headteacher. This means that he is in charge of both Alwyn and Courthouse Schools.






Miss Grierson is the Head of School. This means that she is in charge of Alwyn. This is Mrs McCarthy. She looks after the school office.
